



Congratulations on your new Kitten!!

There are lots of fun times ahead, but there are some things you can do to help keep your Kitten healthy and safe in your first months together.

Worming:

Every 2 weeks until 12 weeks old (then)

Every month until 6 months old (then)

Every 3 months

Flea control:

Depending on the product usually a topical treatment (back of the neck) given monthly for younger cats.

Oral or topical treatments once kitten reaches close to their adult size which are either monthly, 3 monthly or even 6 monthly depending on the product.

Microchipping:

Can be done at any age.

Vaccinations:

The 'core' infectious cat diseases currently present in NZ that we recommend your kitten should be vaccinated against are Cat flu, Enteritis and Feline Aids

Vaccinations are generally given at 3–4-week intervals with the last being given after 16 weeks. This is then followed by yearly boosters.

Desexing:

Can be completed from around 4-6 months of age onwards. This is a day admission procedure which we will be happy to provide further information and an estimate of costs upon request.

Insurance:

Free 8-week Kitten insurance cover. An obligation free period of insurance cover that will give you time to research into companies/plans which you may wish to have your kitten covered with. There are many options for insurance cover, and you will need to do some research to find a cover that suits you if you wish your Kitten to be insured.
